School Information and Procedures

Opening/Closing Times

St. Michael Building:

- From Monday 13th September the school day for Junior Infants and Ms. Dillon's Special Class based in the St. Michael building will begin at 9.30 a.m. and finish at 2.10 p.m.
- The school day for 1st Class based in the St. Michael building will begin at 9.30 a.m. and finish at 3.10 p.m.
- The school day for Ms. Rees and Ms. Redmond's 2nd Classes based in the St. Michael building will begin at 9.30 a.m. and finish at 3.10 p.m.
- The school day for Ms. Noonan's Special Class based in the St. Michael building will begin at 9.30 a.m. and finish at 3.10 p.m.

St. Peter Building:

- The school day for Senior Infants and Ms. Whelan's Special Class based in the St. Peter building will begin at 9.20 a.m. and finish at 2 p.m.
- The school day for Ms. Kissane and Mr. Roche's 2nd Classes based in the St. Peter building will begin at 9.20 a.m. and finish at 3 p.m.
- The school day for Ms. Ireson's Early Intervention class in the St. Peter Building will begin at 9.20 a.m. and will be extended, in consultation with parents, for children as they become ready to attend the full day in the early intervention setting.

Important Rules and Procedures

- The Board of Management cannot accept responsibility for children who arrive before their starting time or who remain on without the permission of the school after their finishing time. A ten minute window (From 9.20 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. in the St. Peter Building and from 9.30 a.m. to 9.40 a.m. in

the St. Michael building) will be supervised to encourage parents to stagger their arrival time and to avoid congregation at the school entrance.

- If a child is being taken from the school before finishing time, either by a parent or someone nominated by the parent, please inform the teacher in advance. The Early Collection Form must be signed.
- If a child arrives late to school the child must be signed in at the office via the Late Arrival Form.
- Children should bring a note of explanation following all absences. The school is legally bound to inform the Child and Family Agency of absences of 20 days or more.
- Any infectious diseases must be notified to the school immediately.
- In the event of a child needing medication during school hours, an indemnity form must be signed by the parent(s)/guardian(s). This form is available from the school. In some cases, a detailed letter of instruction for the administration of the medication must be provided in writing from the child's doctor.
- Aggressive behaviour, whether verbal, psychological, or physical is not allowed. Any behaviour, which interferes with the rights of other children or the health and safety of children or staff to play or to learn, is deemed unacceptable. Abusive language and gestures are not allowed.
- Pupils are required to show respect for each other and to teachers and visitors to the school, at all times.
- Pupils must respect all school property and keep the school environment clean and litter free. Ss. Michael and Peter Junior School is an environmentally friendly school.
- Because of the well-established link between diet and behaviour, children should always bring a sensible, nutritional lunch to school. Crisps, fizzy drinks, sweets or chewing gum are not permitted. The school would prefer if children did not bring their drink in cartons, a secure plastic screw cap bottle is more acceptable.
